Prior to coming to Reading, he spent two years as interim executive minister of the American Baptist Churches of Pennsylvania and Delaware. Immediately prior to that, he was interim pastor at West Shore Baptist Church, Camp Hill, the largest American Baptist church in the Harrisburg area.

MacDonald is a native of Akron, Ohio. Much of his earlier ministry was spent in the hospital chaplaincy.
