

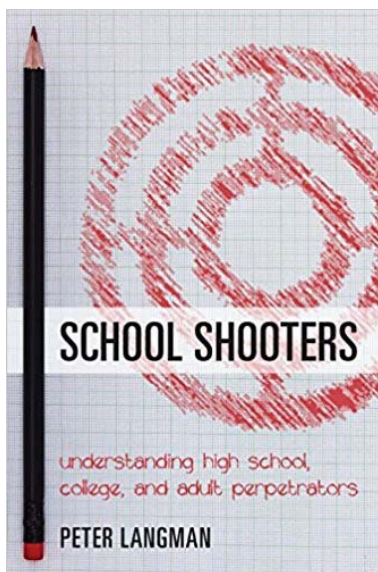
# Knowledge is Power: Be Informed Not Afraid

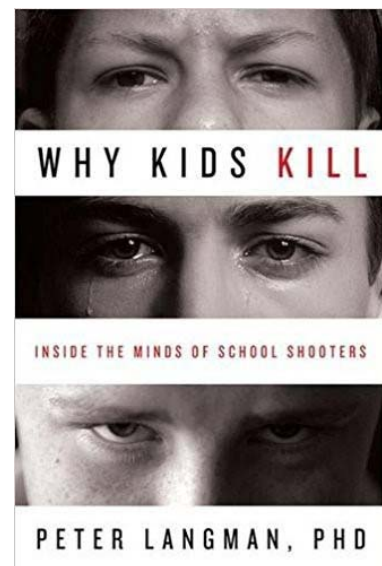
Dr. Langman will discuss the following based on decades of research:
